

## 7 Day 4x4 Eco Trail

### Pre- Tour

(Hotel/Lodge stay)

### Day 1

Crocodile Camp

(Camping)

Day 6  
Mogodi Lodge  
(Lodge stay)

Enjoying a late breakfast in the wild this morning and packing the 4x4's we start making our way back to civilization. We exit the Kruger and drive south toward the historic town of Pilgrims Rest. We spend tonight on the edge of the Blyde River Canyon and enjoy dinner in one of the local restaurants. [B--]
